# Idioms of Symptom Improvement

#### 1. Back on one's feet

- Meaning: Physically healthy again
- **Example**: My mother is **back on her feet** after being <u>under the knife</u>.

Alive And Kicking In good health despite health problems



#### 2. Alive And Kicking

- **Meaning**: In good health despite health problems
- Example: I was under the weather last week, but I'm alive and kicking!



#### 3. As fit as a fiddle

#### \* Fiddle=violin

- **Meaning**: To be healthy and physically fit
- **Example**: I thought *my* grandfather's condition <u>took a turn</u> for the worse but he is **as fit as a fiddle** now that he started eating healthy and exercising.
