

Present Progressive

Subject + To be + **verb**

Use when you are explaining something that is happening right now.

Example: The **shower** is **leaking**.



Present Progressive Negative

Subject + to be + **negative** + **verb**

Use when you are explaining something that is happening right now.


Example: The **shower** is **not** **leaking**.



Using “Can” in Making appointments
