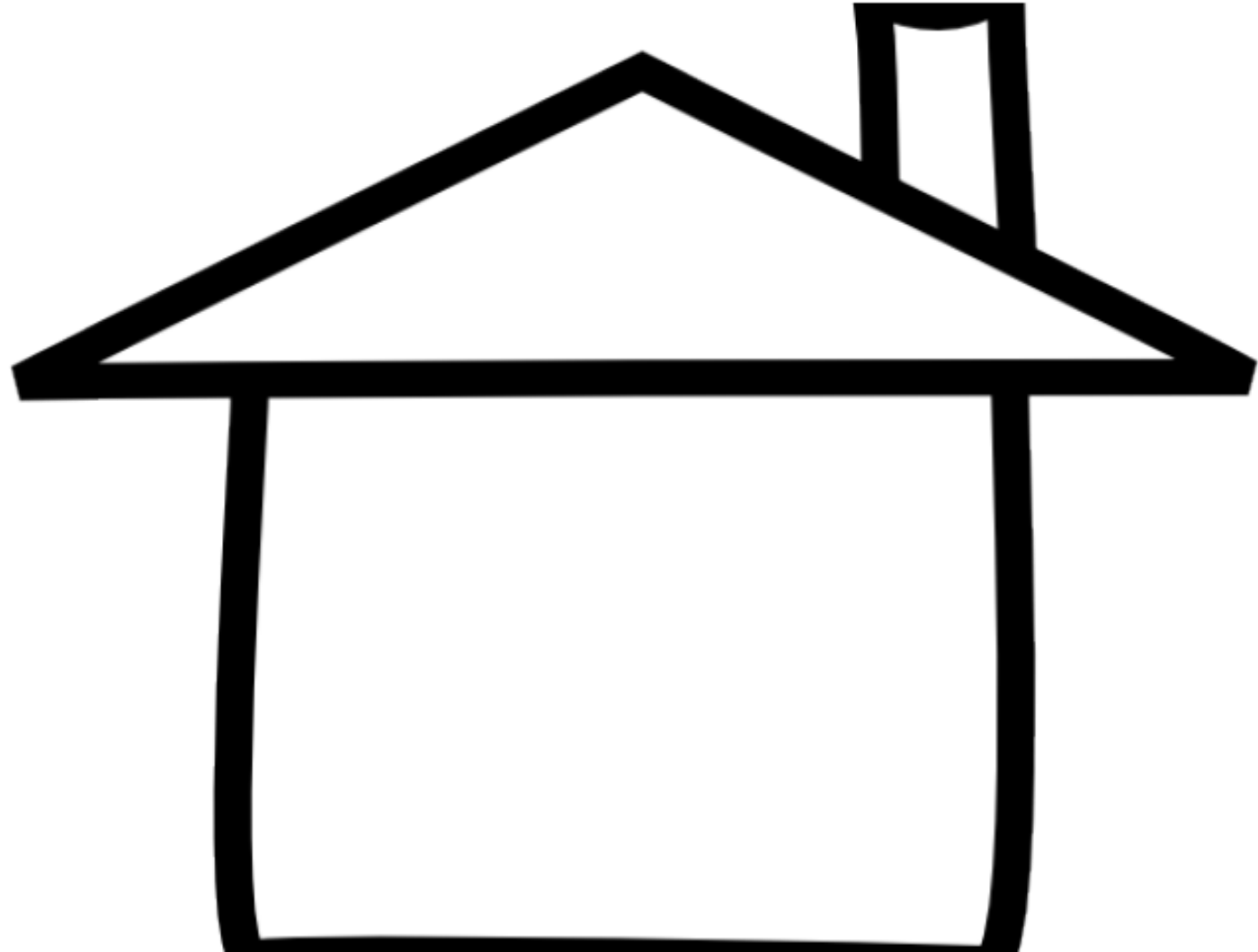

Use when you are explaining something that is happening right now.

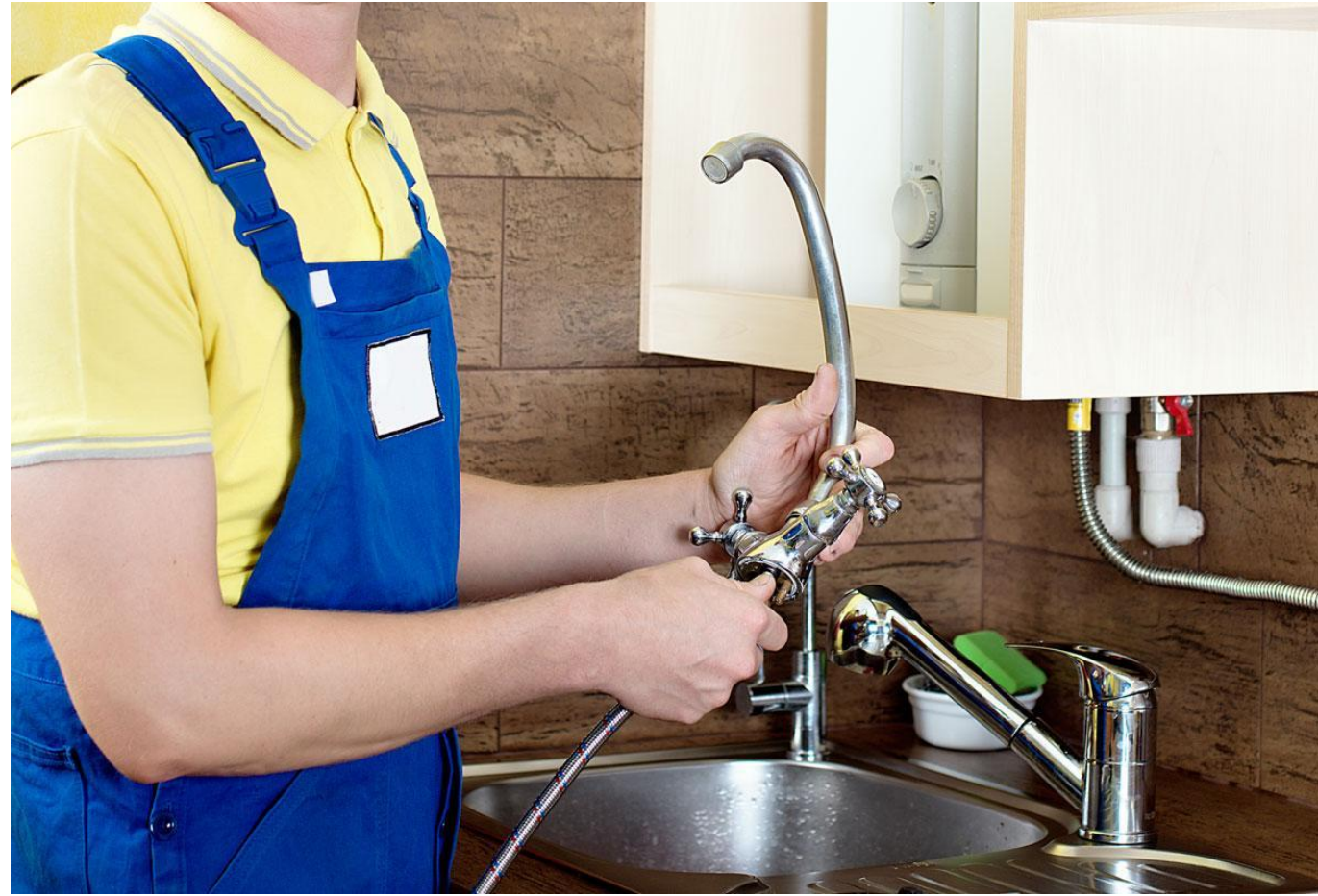
Example: The **shower** is **leaking**.
