



Job titles and Responsibilities

Job Titles	Images	Responsibilities
Doctor (médica/médico)	+	Doctor <u>treats</u> patients at the hospital.
Engineer (ingeniera/ ingeniero)		Engineer <u>builds</u> roads and buildings.

Teacher (profesora/ profesor)	HAPPY TEACHER'S DAY	Teacher <u>teaches</u> students.
Policeman (policía)	CRIME SCENE GO	Policeman <u>catches</u> thieves.
Pilot (piloto)		Pilot <u>operates</u> an airplane.

Scientist	Scientist <u>invents</u> new things.
Soldier	Soldier <u>protects</u> the nation.
Chef	Chef <u>cooks</u> food in hotels and restaurants.

Postman (cartero)	Postman <u>delivers</u> mails.
Bus Driver (conductor de autobús)	Bus driver <u>drives</u> a bus.
Cashier (cajera/cajero)	Cashier <u>receives</u> money.

Group Activity

 Students will answer the questions by describing the job title and responsibility

<Example>

Teacher: Are you a teacher?

Student: Yes, I'm a teacher.

Teacher **teaches** students at school.

or

No, I'm not <u>a teacher.</u> My job is <u>an engineer.</u>
